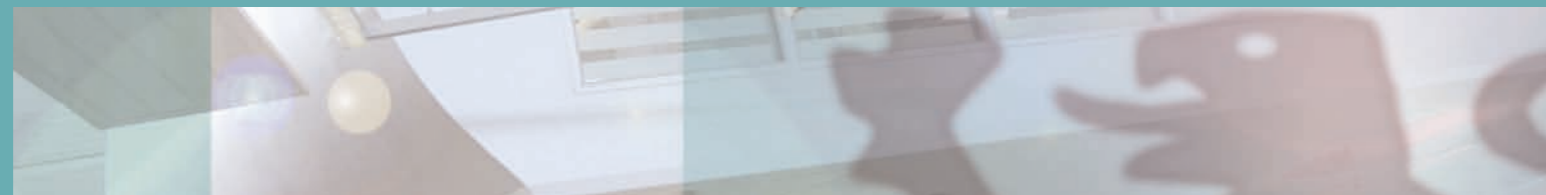

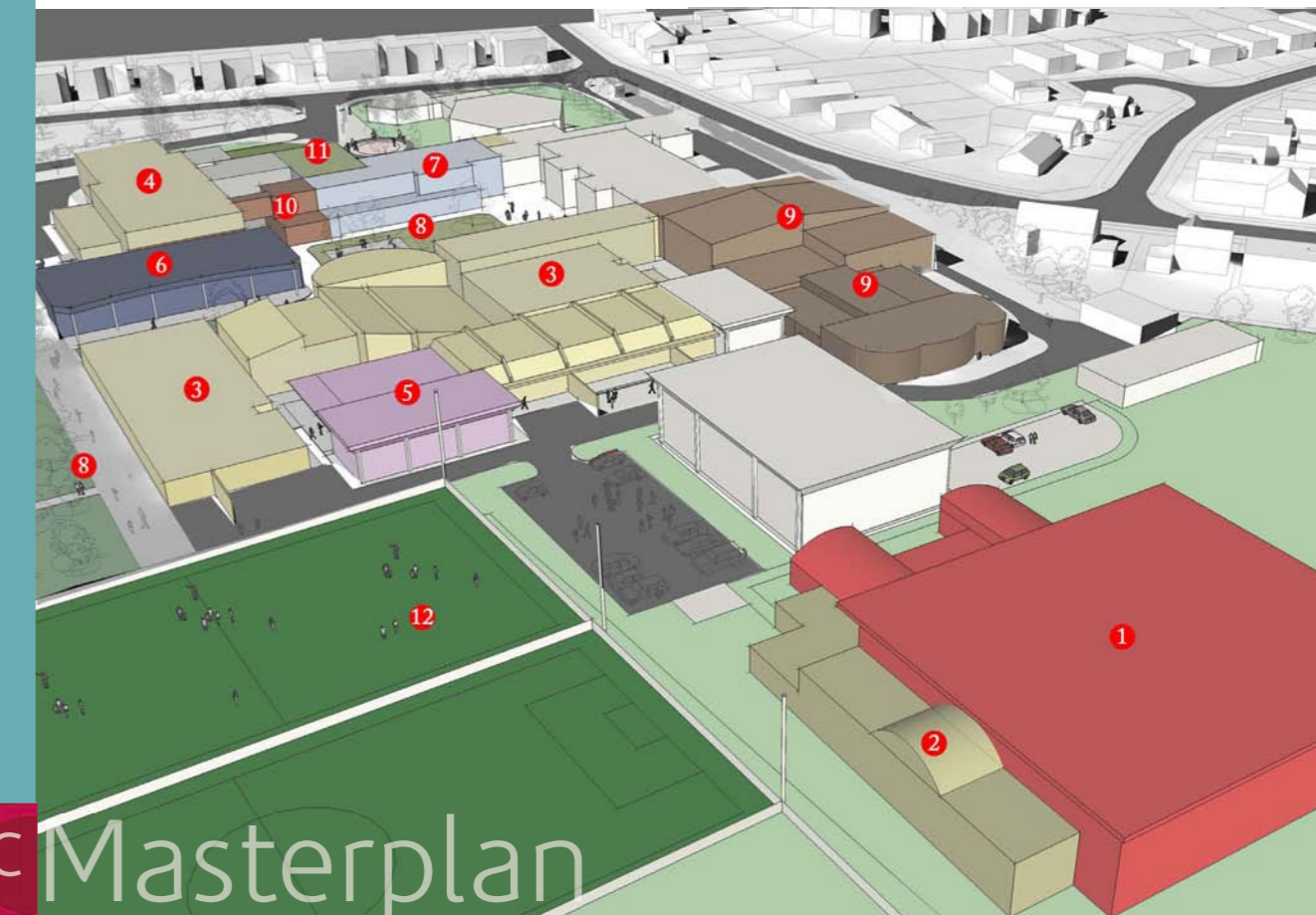
The Beauchamp College

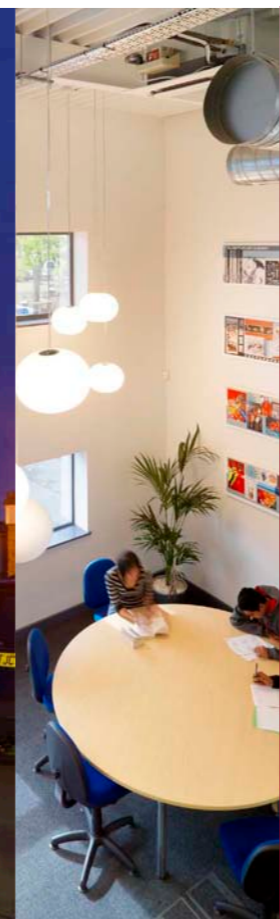
