

NCFE Level 2 Beauty Therapy/Hairdressing

In year 10 you will study the NCFE Certificate in Creative Crafts where you will gain an insight into the world of Beauty Therapy and equip you with skills at various levels depending on the your ability. This programme has also been developed to improve in the first instance your speaking, listening and receptive skills as these are of utmost importance and are required in the work place.

Dedication, time, commitment and regular attendance is required to complete this programme to the required level. You will also be required to wear a suitable uniform, no jeans or trainers and only small stud earrings in order for assessments to take place. All practical aspects of the programme will be demonstrated and observed by the teacher. There will be various methods of assessment that take place including oral questions, photographic evidence, mood boards etc.

What is included?

Manicure, Nail Art and Make up

You will also be required to build a portfolio to show all aspects of your skills, if you work and study hard this will lead you onto to an NVQ in Beauty Therapy. This is the first stepping stone into the world of Beauty therapy.

Year 11 - Hairdressing

Awarding Body: NCFE **Course title:** Creative Craft using Hairdressing level 2

In Year 11 you will acquire a basic understanding of tools equipment, health and safety and hairdressing skills areas that are required to give foundation knowledge in Hairdressing. You will develop your research skills and evaluate your work learning through the hairdressing process.

What can I do at the end of the course?

With further training or study, you can progress onto the City & Guilds level 2 VRQ in Hairdressing.

An additional qualification is the Level 2 qualification awarded by City & Guilds called Contact Dermatitis Prevention, a qualification to assist motivation, which is offered alongside the NCFE.

Please note that there is a charge for the equipment and uniform needed to study these two courses.
