Overview of subject:

In A-Level Drama and Theatre Studies, you will practically explore engaging and inspiring play texts. You will work in a range of different theatrical styles and learn about the work of highly influential theatre practitioners. The course will be assessed through a combination of performance work, course work and written examinations.

Topics studied in the syllabus include:

- Devising theatre in the style of Bertolt Brecht
- Accidental Death of an Anarchist by Dario Fo (Commedia Dell Arte and Political Farce)
- Woyzeck by George Buchner in the style of Antonin Artaud
- Evaluating live theatre
