

Post 16 Catch Up Plan 2020-21



Identification

In order to target support to the right students we have identified the 27 students who did not attain a GCSE grade 5 in Mathematics or English Language in 2020. From these students we have identified which subjects they are currently underperforming in.

Communication

Teachers will be notified that students have been identified as part of the Catch-up Plan and asked in the first instance to use existing assessments to identify areas of underperformance in individual subjects.

Students will be notified through either a conversation with their Head of Year or the Head of Key Stage 5.

Parents will receive a letter outlining the requirement for additional support, the provision available, and the timeframe for review.
